COVID-19 VIRUS – INFORMATION UPDATE

CLUB CLOSED BUT TAKE AWAY STILL AVAILABLE

The Prime Minister has last night announced that registered clubs, along with other hospitality venues, are required to cease operating from Midday, Monday 23 March 2020, so as to slow the spread of Covid-19.

Accordingly, this club is now closed until further notice and all functions, events and bowls are cancelled. A limited take away service for food and liquor is still available.

Under the provisions of the forced closure and the terms of our liquor license we can continue to sell take away liquor and food providing certain conditions are met.

Effective Tuesday 24th March 2020 this club will offer a takeaway liquor and food service under the following conditions. Please note patrons must comply with all directions given to them by staff.

Liquor and Other Products

- Take away liquor purchases will be available 7 days from 3pm to 8pm.
- During these time patrons may also purchase tobacco products, ice etc. and use the cigarette and general vending machines.
- 1 customer at a time will be permitted to purchase take away liquor from the bar
- All purchases by debit/credit card or club account card only unless prior arrangements made
- Access to the club will be controlled via the double doors located between the main entrance and the front veranda. The main entrance and the rear doors of the club will be locked.
- No access to other parts of the club will be permitted

Food – Chans Chinese & Surfside Pizza

- Chans Chinese take away will be available Wed, Thurs, Fri, Sat & Sun 5pm to 8pm (last order 7.45)
- Surfside Pizza take away will be available Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri, Sat & Sun 5pm to 8pm (last order 7.45)
- Please phone orders in advance where possible
- All purchases by debit/credit card only unless prior arrangements made. Card surcharge will not apply during this period
- Orders and pickups will occur at the double doors located between the main entrance and the front veranda. The main entrance and the rear doors of the club will be locked.
- No access to other parts of the club will be permitted
